Get prepared by the best. We offer exciting trainings at NO CHARGE to the volunteer.

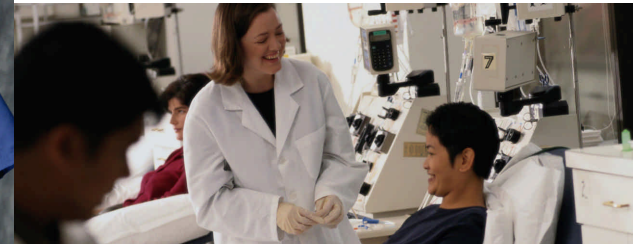
Broaden your horizons.

Network with other health care professionals and experts in the field at fun events and yearly meetings.

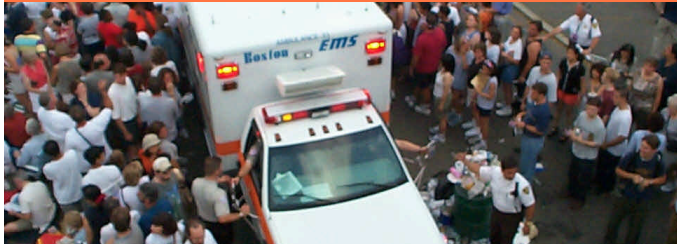


What role might I play?
